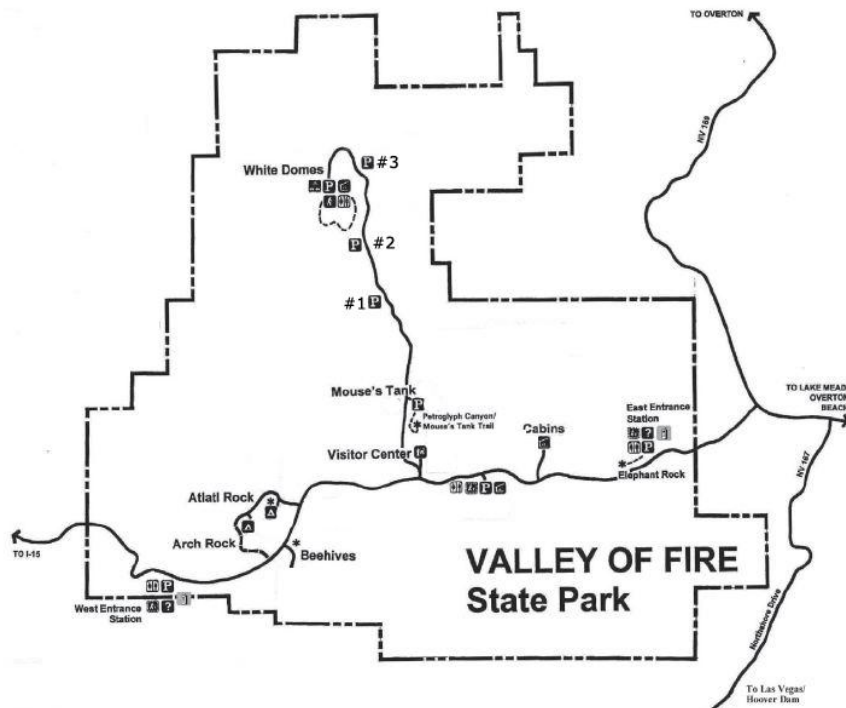


Directions to White Domes Trail

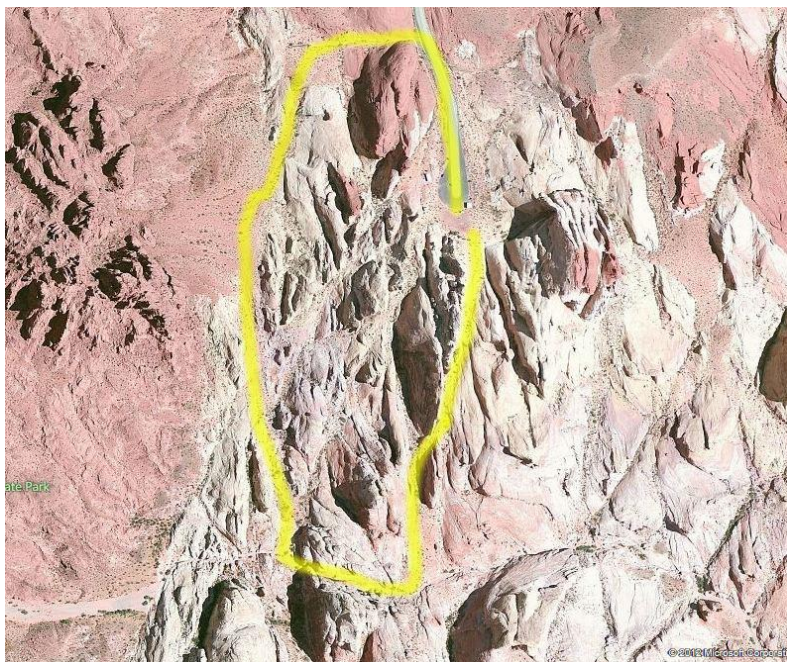
Getting There

The White Domes Trail is located in the Valley of Fire State Park, in south-eastern Nevada, accessed from Interstate I15.

- If coming from the north take exit 93 and travel south east on the N Moapa Valley Boulevard, route 169, through Overton, Nevada, 20.0 miles to the Valley of Fire Highway.
- The eastern park entry is 2.0 miles along this road to the pay station.
- You need cash or a check to pay for the \$10 one day entry permit.
- If coming from the south take exit 75 onto the Valley of Fire Highway and travel 14.5 miles east to the west park entry station.
- The White Domes Trailhead is 5 miles



north of the park Visitor Center. Park in the large parking lot at the end of the road.



The Trail

The hike starts at the White Domes parking area and the route is well marked.

- First, you will travel south and slightly uphill through some very fine sand.
- Then you work your way down a fairly steep canyon to an old movie set towards the bottom.
- From the movie set, you have a short walk down into a wash and turn right (west) to follow the wash into a narrow slot canyon.
- Beyond the slot canyon the trail turns right and travels north up the far side of the white domes.
- Eventually the trail rejoins the road below the parking area.
